## RIVERHEAD CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT ANNOUNCES THE UNIVERSAL PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR

The Riverhead Central School District is accepting applications for the District's Universal Pre-Kindergarten Program for September 2010. This will be the thirteenth year that the district will be participating in this New York State program. This program provides half-day pre-kindergarten class 5 days per week for eligible children who will be four years old on or before December 1, 2010. Transportation is only provided to the district's programs.

The district is required to give priority to economically disadvantaged children. **However, the program is open to all district residents and we encourage all parents to apply for the program.** In the past twelve years, we have been able to register all children who wanted to participate in this program.

The Universal Pre-Kindergarten is designed to promote cognitive, linguistic, and psychosocial growth in young children. The program will be offered at various private pre-school sites within the geographic boundaries of our district. All children selected to participate in the program must meet all New York State health and immunization requirements prior to attending. Original birth certificate, proof of residency (utility bill and photo identification) and income tax return for 2009 is required.

Participation will be first determined by family income and other criteria established by the UPK Advisory Committee.
